The District Community Development Programme gone through various programmes in different places under the Gohpur Sub-Division and Biswanath Sub-Division in the district of Sonitpur Assam during the period of April/07 – March/08 and experienced the familiarities under the following components. 1.0 Community Development.

1.1.- Community Health and awareness Programme

a) Report from C.D.O. Selaikhati pocket Area

The Community Organizer Of Bheludanga pocket area reported that, most of the villages of this area are very badly effected in malaria, Jaundice during this month. The people of Karibil Sapori, Tokowbari, Karibil Bongali, Bhelasapori, and Nagabil are very badly affected. A few people of these areas lost their lives too. So C.D.O. of this area requested for malaria check-up camp as soon as possible. As per his report the following activities were carried out within the period at Bheludanga pocket area.

b) Field report form the C.H.W. Selaikhati area:- The community health worker of Selaikhati pocket area has reported that Bhimajuli, Tarajuli, Kherbari and other area also very badly effected in malaria disease. Theses area are very interior place and far from the medical facilities. Most of the community people of this area are under BPL categories. So the CHW of this area requested malaria check up camp as soon as possible.

C) Malaria and General Health Check up Camp:- Under the community development programme two days malaria check up camp was conducted on 21<sup>st</sup> June at Tarajuli L.P. School and another camp was held on 22<sup>nd</sup> at Bhimajuli L.P. School to keep the request of Village Development Committee and their locality. The camp held with the help of Medical Department, Government of Assam. First day in this check up camp total 145 patients were checked up among them 5nos of P.F. and 7nos P.V. malaria patients were identified and rest of all were found as normal. On the second days malaria check up camp total 105 patients were attended the camp among them 6Nos P.F. patients and 3Nos P.V. malaria were identified. And rest patients were found as a normal condition.

Keeping view in mind the heavy demands of the Community Health workers of Bheludanga Pkt. Area the District Community development Programme DCDP conducted one long “Malaria & general Health check up camp” at DCDP Campus Bheludanga on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2007 in co-operation with State Health Center (Civil Hospital) Government of Assam.

In this “Malaria & general Health check up camp” there were all together 188 patients form thirteen Nos. of village community people took participation in this camp. Out of 188 patients 11 nos of PF malaria and 2 PV malaria affected patients were deducted and rest of patients found as a normal .

The organization in co-operation with Health department Govt. of Assam jointly provided medical services and distributed the medicine among the patients on that very day.

### **Planning and Monitoring (Pocket Level Bheluadanga Area)**

The community organizer of Bheluadanga Pkt. Area supposed to organize various programme in this Pkt. area , but due to “Assam Bandh” and his poor health condition he could not arranged any programme during the month.

The **District Community Development Programme** in collaboration with **Sonitpur Baptist Christian Centre** and **Joint Director of Health Services Govt of Assam, Sonitpur District** organized 4 emergency Anti Malaria and General Health Check-up camps at **Balisang, Tarajulli, Salaikhati, and Morikhuti** of Biswanath Circle under Biswanath sub-division, where altogether 647 patients were treated by the Doctors from Biswanath Chariali Civil Hospital. Details are given bellow.
