1. Title

Emergency Flood Relief Assistance for Flood-Affected Families in Sivasagar, Nazira and Charaideo Districts, Assam

2. Background:

The recent devastating floods in the districts of Sivasagar, Nazira and Charaideo, Assam, India



have caused widespread destruction and immense human suffering. Thousands of families have been severely affected by prolonged flooding, leading to the loss of lives, destruction of homes, damage to agricultural land, loss of livestock, and disruption of livelihoods.

Many affected families are currently living in temporary shelters or with relatives, lacking adequate food, clean drinking water, clothing, sanitation facilities,

5. Proposed Relief Package:

Each relief package may include:

Rice

Dal (lentils)

Edible oil

Salt

Sugar

Biscuits

Drinking water

Soap and hygiene materials

Tarpaulin sheets

Blankets
Mosquito nets
Candles and matchboxes
Basic medicines and first-aid supplies
Clothing for adults and children

6. Target Beneficiaries:

The project aims to support the most vulnerable flood-affected households, especially:

- ✓ Families who lost their homes
- ✓ Families who lost family members
- ✓ Widows and elderly persons
- ✓ Persons with disabilities
- ✓ Children
- ✓ Farmers and daily wage labourers who lost crops and livestock

7. Implementation Strategy:

The relief distribution will be carried out in collaboration with local community leaders, churches, village committees, volunteers, and local authorities to ensure transparency, accountability, and fair distribution based on need.

8. Expected Outcomes:

Immediate food and essential needs met for affected families.

Improved health and hygiene conditions.

Reduced suffering among vulnerable households.

Strengthened community resilience through timely humanitarian assistance.

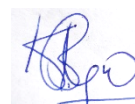
